

Guidelines for Teachers for running the Solar Eclipse lesson via the ISE platform

1. Enter the Solar Eclipse 2015 Community at the ISE Portal (<http://portal.opendiscoveryspace.eu/community/solar-eclipse-2015-820410>)
2. For the lesson in English: once in the above community go to the “Resources” and click on the lesson you are interested in (for Elementary School, Junior High School or Upper High School).

For the lesson in other languages (Greek, Portuguese, Spanish, German, Italian, Finnish, Dutch, Croatian, Romanian, Bulgarian): once in the above community join the sub-community that has the lessons in the language of your interest (e.g. Solar Eclipse Greek Community) and there within the “Resources” click on the lesson you are interested in (for Elementary School Junior High School or Upper High School).

2. Press the option “clone” and you will be re-directed to the ISE Authoring Tool, where you have to press the clone option again.
3. The lesson will be cloned in your personal account and you will be redirected to the edit metadata page. You don't have to edit the metadata. You have to press from the top bar the option: “My Lessons and Scenarios”.
4. Finally, you have to press the option “Deliver Lesson”. The system will produce two unique URLs, namely:
 - the Teacher URL, which should be used by the teacher, so as to monitor students' data
 - The Student URL, which should be used by the students to access the Solar Eclipse Lesson, and see the lesson content (at the end of each phase there is a section for questions that is inactivated. In order to proceed just ask your students to randomly select an answer)
5. If you want to use the Solar Eclipse with another class. You have to re-press the option “Deliver Lesson” again
